

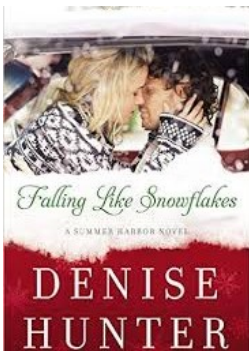
# Library News

## New Items

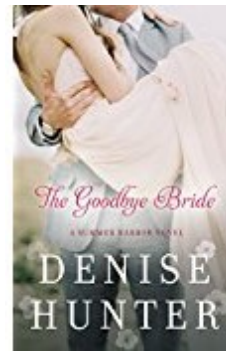

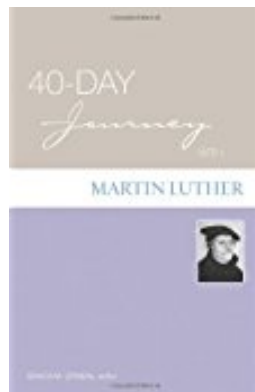
Beau will go to the ends of the earth to keep her safe. But who's going to protect his heart from a woman who can't seem to trust again?
