At the August 12th church council meeting, a call committee was appointed by the council. There are 8 voting members on the call committee and 1 non-voting member. Three members of the call committee are from the council and include: Brendan Schardt, Stuart Reinke, and Marty Pohlmann. Five members of the call committee are from the congregation and include: Paul Meyer, Bill Mize, Kim Roth, Linda Loontjer, and Connie Eitzmann. Marla Maschmann is a non-voting member of the committee. On August 14th the call committee held its first meeting in which Bill Mize was elected chairman. A congregational profile has been set up on the LCMC website to begin the call process.
