## **Projects:**

publish community invitations to worship, decide on a theme for Lenten services, consider suggestion to improve our worship, plan special worship events, renovate the dossal curtain behind the altar, develop a welcome packet for visitors, etc.

# **Membership and Friendship Team**

Goal: To deepen a sense of belonging and community among our members.

## Projects:

organize fellowship events, send birthday greetings to members in 2014, update the church photo directory, welcome new members, reach out to inactive members, etc.

## **Discipleship and Education Team**

Goal: To strengthen our educational ministry to children, youth, and adults.

#### **Projects:**

support and improve our Sunday School, support and improve our youth ministry, support and improve our preschool, etc.

## **Ministry and Mission Team**

Goal: To involve more people in serving Christ by serving the needs of world.

# Projects:

set priorities for Peace mission giving, encourage support of Peace mission partners, recruit volunteers to serve at Peace, decide on a Mission Festival guest, etc.

Each team will meet in January and February and then once after Lent. Then the teams will meet three times in August, September, and October or November. We will usually meet on Wednesday evenings.
