

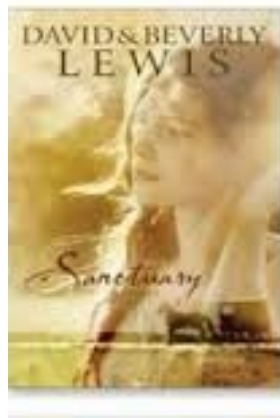
# Library News

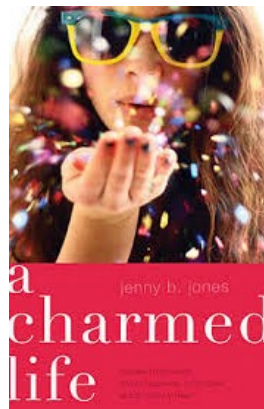


Unravel the message behind a treasured quilt as you meet Emilie and Noah, two people seeking to find answers and a place to belong in frontier Nebraska.
