PEACE LUTHERAN CHURCH SEEKING SCHOLARSHIP DONATIONS...

In May of 2015, Peace Lutheran Church gave one \$400.00 scholarship for a communing member of Peace Lutheran Church who was enrolled at a seminary or college. This year Peace would like to offer another \$400.00 scholarship to a communing member, but because of the low return on investments the amount of accumulated interest of the Endowment Funds designated for the scholarship is not enough to fund the entire scholarship. As we want to continue the \$400.00 scholarship as in the past, donations are being requested. All financial gifts received will be used to meet that goal. Please leave donations marked "*Scholarship*" in the office or the offering plate.

Applications will be available on the counter in the church office for the 2016 scholarship. Preference is given to students closer to the completion of their bachelor's degree and those attending Christian colleges or seminaries. The scholarship deadline has been moved to <u>June 1, 2016</u>.

COLLECTING PRESCRIPTION PILL CONTAINERS...

The Prayerfully Simple Bible Study group is accumulating prescription pill containers to send to the Malawi Project (www.malawiproject.org). This is a simple way to recycle something of value that most of us dispose of and end up in local landfills.

We invite you to save your containers when you have completed your prescription. Remove the label and glue and wash them. They prefer the smaller bottles to save shipping space and because the Malawi medical personnel rarely distribute a large amount of medicine at any one time. ("Do not send the large vitamin containers!")

Healthcare and education in Malawi suffer from a lack of adequate funds, resources, and trained personnel. In 2008, estimates were 0.02 doctors for every 100,000 people, as compared with 2.42 in the U.S. Hospitals continue to be wholly inadequate when it comes to supplies, equipment, and personnel; and patients are often turned away because of critical shortages. In Malawi, medical providers may use torn pieces of paper for wrapping medicine for their patients. The prescription containers will help families keep their medicine clean and out of reach of small children.
