# Peace Lutheran Church - 135 Years

135 years ago, a small group of German-speaking families in the Friedensau area notheast of Deshler began meeting together for worship at the Friedensau public school building. These families had withdrawn from Trinity Lutheran Church - Missouri Synod at Friedensau in order to form a new Lutheran congregation. In 1883 Pastor Carl Buechler came to Thayer County as a missionary of the Ohio Synod. In August of 1883 he met with ten men to begin the organization of this new congregation. On November 13, 1883, "The German Evangelical Lutheran Friedens (or Peace) Congregation, Unaltered Augsburg Confession, at Friedensau, Thayer County, Nebraska" was officially incorporated.

This November, we celebrate 135 years as the family of God here at Peace Lutheran Church. We decided a night of fellowship, food and music would be a fun way to share our ministry here at Peace. So please join us on Friday evening, November 16, at 5:30 for a meal and then at 7:00 p.m. we will enjoy the music and stories of Dave Anderson and Roger Walck. There is a **sign-up sheet on the church bulletin board to furnish soup or sandwiches for the meal**. We've invited area churches to join us, so please help us furnish a nice meal by signing up. Special thanks to Mindy Stichka and Tiffany Beam for organizing the event and the Youth of Peace for offering to help host the meal.

#### Winter Weather Closing Policy

Because of the high priority we place on gathering for worship and ministry activities each week, Peace Lutheran Church has rarely closed due to hazardous weather. However, if we do have a heavy snowfall, ice, or other severe winter weather

conditions, we observe the following practices:

• On Weekdays: If the Deshler Schools either cancel classes or dismiss early for inclement weather, then all daytime, afternoon and evening activities at Peace Lutheran Church will be cancelled, too. The office may be opened if it is safe for staff to venture out. Exception: If there is a funeral on the day of a weather closing day, any decisions about postponement will be made in consultation with the church office, family, and the funeral home. The answering machine will carry any announcements concerning closing, and notices will be posted on the Peace Lutheran website and on TV stations listed on this page.

For any cancellations related to Peace Preschool: Parents of students are advised to consult their handbook for the standing policies related to weather closings.

• On Weekends and Church Holidays: If there is a winter storm warning or other hazardous weather on these days, any schedule changes will be determined by the Pastor and Council President by 7 AM on Sundays and announced as soon as possible on the church answering machine, website and TV stations listed on this page. It may not be possible to get announcements to all media about Saturday evening changes, but if a Saturday evening service is cancelled we will at least try to put an announcement on the Peace answering machine.

**Reminder:** Local weather and driving conditions can vary widely throughout the towns and countryside served by Peace Lutheran Church. Regardless of where you live, please make good, safe decisions about traveling to church in winter weather. Let common sense and safety be your guide. Even if services continue for those who can make it, others may find it safer to stay off the roads and worship at home when severe storms are in progress.

More information would be obtained on this.

**Old Business** – Mother's Room had been cleaned prior to the meeting. It was suggested to clean the Mother's Room in conjunction with kitchen cleaning. Anita reported on the WOW Heartland Retreat that 6 members had attended. Jami had purchased hooks for the upstairs room used for bridal parties getting ready. The hooks would lay flat against the wall when not in use.

**New Business** – The terms of five board members, Jami, Joan, Connie, Jae and Becky are up at the end of the year. Those not planning on staying on for another term are to find their replacements.

It was noted that December 2<sup>nd</sup> would be Appreciation Sunday for all the donations received throughout the year with Board members serving cookies after church. Each member is to bring 2 dozen cookies that Sunday.

The meeting was adjourned and closed with the Lord's Prayer.
