Sunday, Nov. 22, 7:00 p.m. Activity Night at the YOP house.

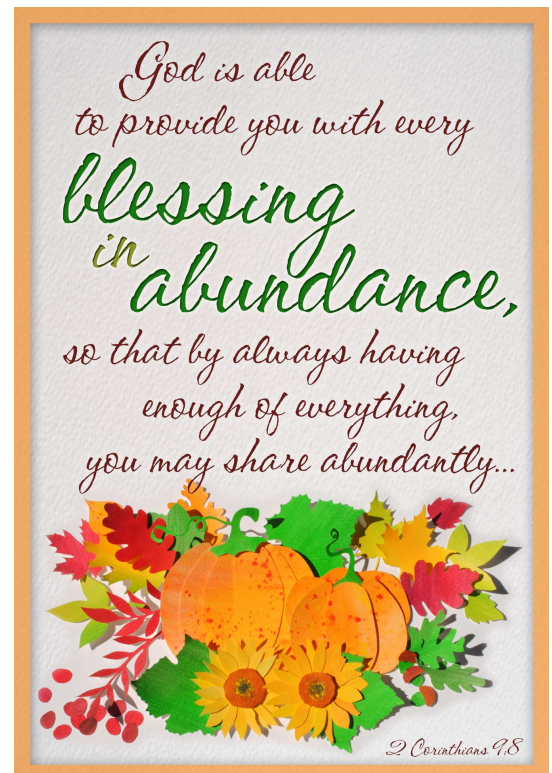
