

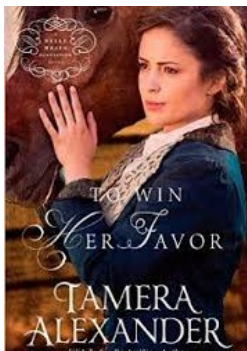

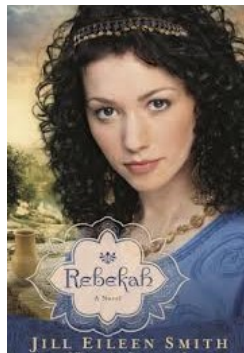

New Items



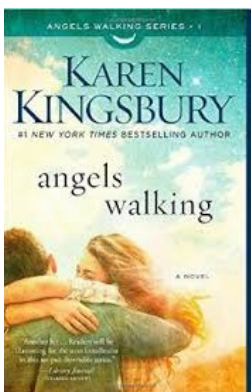

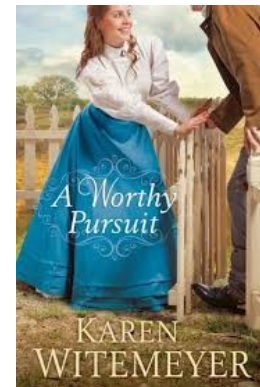
