

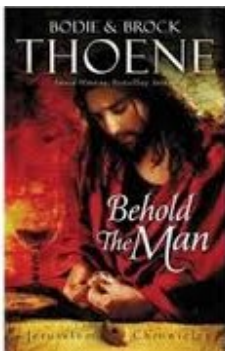

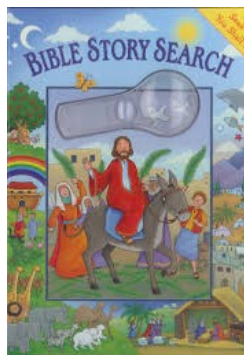

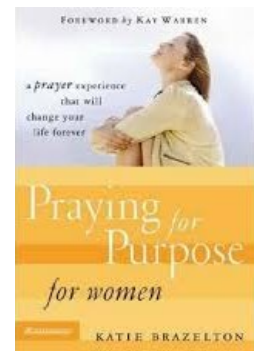
New Items



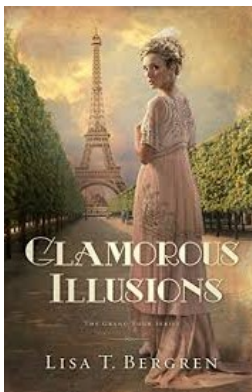
